

Inside this booklet, you'll find an overview of our Junior events for the season. We offer a variety of programs tailored to different ages and experience levels. Our 3-Tier system, introduced last year, continues to help group juniors by skill and experience level, ensuring they are placed in the right programs to maximize their development. Additionally, we are continuing our use of the Operation 36 model in 2025, further integrating it into our group lessons and certain Junior Nights. This structured approach helps juniors progress by learning to shoot 36 over 9 holes, starting from 25 yards and advancing as they achieve new milestones.

For Junior Girls, youll notice our Bearspaw Girls Club is expanding this season to have more sessions, and to include an indoor social aspect following the lessons where the girls will participate in indoors activities after their lesson.

We also are excited to build on our elite coaching programs for competitive Juniors with our Grizzly Bear Groups for Junior Boys, and Polar Bear Group for tier 3 Junior Girls.

## 2025 JUNIOR CODE OF CONDUCT

Bearspaw Golf Club takes pride in all of its members and facilities. Golf is a game of respect and honour for yourself, your fellow competitors and the golf course. The Code of Conduct below identifies the basic standards we require from our Junior golfers at Bearspaw Golf Club.

#### **DRESS CODE:**

Proper golf attire is required while using the golf facilities. This includes:

- Clothing worn in a neat and respectable manner.
- Collared shirts for boys and for girls either golf tops or golf dresses.
- Tailored golf pants, tailored joggers, golf shorts or skirts for girls.
- Boys shirts preferably tucked in.
- Jeans, sweat pants, short shorts, all athletic wear, tank tops, or sleeveless shirts (boys) are not permitted.
- Hats to be worn forward at all times.

## **GOLF CART POLICY**

Juniors at Bearspaw are expected to walk their rounds. Juniors with a valid driver's license and at least 16 years of age may, on occasion, take a power cart if conditions allow, paying the full fee for their round and checking into the golf course. For example, pace of play needed to be quicker, inclement weather projected, extreme hot conditions, or if the Junior has some type of injury that prohibits walking the course. If a Junior takes a cart under these conditions it is expected they follow our guidelines of respecting the course and fellow golfers and driving the golf cart in a responsible manner and following all signage on the course. There is a one strike policy in regard to golf cart and abuse of the rules, checking in, or not paying for carts, which will result in an immediate suspension of golf cart privileges for the remainder of the golf season.

## ALCOHOL, TOBACCO OR DRUGS

Use of drugs will not be tolerated. Use of alcohol and tobacco is not permitted at the golf course. For Juniors who are 18 years of age, use of these products is not permitted at Junior events.

## BEHAVIOUR AT OTHER CLUBS

When visiting other golf clubs, you are a guest and are representing yourself as well as Bearspaw. We ask you respect the values, standards and policies of the host club when visiting and represent Bearspaw in a professional and positive fashion.

## GOLF COURSE AND CLUBHOUSE BEHAVIOUR

The golf club is an adult environment and although we always promote having fun, we ask you respect other patrons of the course and behave in a mature manner at all times. Abusive or inappropriate conduct or language, including temperamental outbursts, throwing or breaking of clubs, any form of cheating or abuse of the golf course or the facilities is unacceptable and will not be tolerated. Any disrespect of the golf course, golf shop or serving staff will not be tolerated.

## VIOLATIONS OF THE CODE OF CONDUCT

If a minor violation occurs, the individual will be prohibited from further participation until he/she complies with the above code and will be given a written warning. The individual must do so without delay and maintain the standard. Any actions considered serious may result in the individual being removed or excluded from any Junior Programs or activities until the incident is reviewed by the Professional Staff. Multiple written warnings will come with a suspension of playing rights and potentiall dismissal from the program.



## **PURPOSE OF OUR JUNIOR PROGRAM**

- To provide instruction for Junior Golfers to learn the game, etiquette and rules.
- To provide a growth opportunity for recreational and competitive players.
- Allow Juniors to make new friends and build life long relationships.
- To provide mentorship and exemplify core values of respect, honesty and integrity.
- To have fun and enjoy the game!

# BEARSPAW OPERATION 36 PROGRAM - TIER 1 & 2

Introduced last season, the Operation 36 Program is the perfect development program from Tier 1 and 2 Juniors. This program consists of 8 group lessons using our practice facilities, and 4 Play Nights on the course where Juniors test the skills they've learned. Juniors new to this program would begin at Level 1, starting from 25 yards on each hole to begin. The Juniors goal is shoot 36 from their level, and if accomplished they 'Level Up' for the next Play Night, and move back to the next starting yardage. 25, 50, 100, 150 and so on. 
